Organisation



Universiteit Antwerpen

- Until 2003
 - 3 universities: UFSIA, RUCA, UIA
- 2004
 - Merger: ONE Universiteit Antwerpen
- 4 Sites
 - City Campus : Humanities & Social Sciences
 - Middelheim/Groenenborger : Sciences
 - Drie Eiken : Bio(medical) Sciences




Librairies from 2008 onwards


- City campus : Humanities & Social Sciences
- Middelheim : Mathematics and Informatics
- Groenenborger : Sciences
- Drie Eiken : Bio(medical) Sciences



Librairies from 2013 onwards

- Flemish polytechnics (only academic masters) integrate in the University. In Antwerp:
 - Campus Hoboken: Engineering
 - Campus Mutsaerd: Architecture, Industrial Design, Restauration /Conservation
 - Campus Zuid: Applied linguistics and translations
- Integrated and closed
 - Campus Paardenmarkt: engineering
 - Campus Merksem: fysiotherapy





Result : long term



- 2016
 - Merger of libraries at Middelheim/Groenenborger
 - Merger with libraries of engineering
 - 1 new library for the sciences at Groenenborger
 - Linguistics/translators will merge into city library
 - New student learning center at Middelheim
 - Renovated library/ student learning center and making space at **Groenenborger**
 - Renovated library at Drie Eiken



Impact of the merger

- Huge impact on university, and also on libraries
- Lots of work:
 - Buildings
 - Staff
 - Selection, acquisiton en cataloguing
 - Budget



Library management

- Management
 - Chief librarian
 - 1 campus librarian
 - 1 coordinator for library automation (Anet)
 - 1 technical advisor (Anet)
 - Library policy & Decision making
- Heads of departments
 - Advise
 - Management daily activities



Role of the academic staff

- Library Advisory Board
 - Vice rector and representatives of all faculties
 - Advise about the library policy (strategic plan)
- Faculty library committees
 - Advise about issues concerning the faculty in relation to the library



Role of the academic staff

- Library advisor
 - Professor in a faculty
 - Decides together with his collegues what the library should buy
 - Member of Library Advisory Board



Budget

- Staff
 - +/- 73 FTE
 - Allocated budget managed by HR department
- Acquisitons
 - General: central library budget 345 K€
 - Specialized: faculties: approx. 3,2 M€
- Buildings, infrastructure, ICT
 - Allocated by departments Infrastructure & ICT







Paper collection

- +/- 1.467.124 volumes
- +/- 3.651 printed journals
- Profile of library collection: planned
 - Collection evaluation
 - Definition of collection profiles
 - Collection plan
- Merger of university: result : reorganization and evaluation of collections at 4 campuses

Paper collection: +/-

- City Campus: 1.214.461 volumes
 - 500.000 in open stacks
 - 800.000 in closed stacks
- Middelheim: 31.264 volumes
- Groenenborger: 52.795 volumes
- Drie Eiken: 101.551 volumes
- And three other campusses: not yet counted





Paper collection

- Universal Decimal Classification
 - Local version
- Efficiency of loan
 - Brocade
 - Up-to-date integrated library system
 - Developed by company Anet



Digital collection

- Catalogues
- E-journals
- Databases
- Website



Collections for education/research

- Both e.g.
 - Law
 - Dedicated library to practice
 - Library and information studies
 - Medicine
- Research
 - In open and closed stacks



ICT Infrastructure

ICT infrastructure (Oct 2015)

- City campus
 - 244 PCs (in classes and free access)
 - 40 thin clients
- Middelheim/Groenenborger
 - 52 PCs free access
- Drie Eiken
 - 44 PCs free access
 - 140 in 4 PC classes
- And 2 other campusses CZU, CHO

L ICT infrastructure

- Internet: state-of-the-art
- Wireless network in all campuses
- Copying/printing/scanning facilities available
 - New copiers in September 2015
 - Copy cards
- Digitization of old books and prints
- Integrated library system Brocade
 - In-house development from Anet



Services



Access

- Registration:
 - students and staff from UA
 - students and staff from the association of the university and the schools for professional bachelors (polytechnics)
 - Antwerp Management School
 - all people 18 years and older (10 euro per year)
 - library card
- We have usage statistics



Opening hours

- Differences per campus
- E.g. City campus
 - 8:30 21:00 Mon-Thur
 - 8:30 19:00 Fri
 - 10:00 17:00 Sat
 - See website
 - Opening hours are enlarged



Services

- Training information literacy
 - Often in cooperation with faculty staff
- Information desks
 - Each campus has a general information desk
 - City campus
 - 6 desks for faculties Humanities and Social Sciences
 - 1 desk for the historical collections
- No subject specialists



Services

- Library website
 - New external website in July 2014
 - New internal website for staff of UAntwerpen: November 2014
 - We will develop our website further
 - First point of entrée
- SFX available
- VPN for use at home 24*7



Inter Library Loan

- Impala
- Belgian system for Inter library loan
- We lend books to other organisations
 - 2011: pilot with delivery of articles to our own faculty members: was succesfull
- Efficient system to locate the resource
- Delivery of articles

Support for publications researchers

- Academic Bibliography (since 1991)
- Institutional Repository
- Software developed by Anet
- Contents:
 - Books and articles by researchers
 - PhD theses
 - Master theses
- (Temporary) embargo is possible
- Planned: Research data

Support for researchers

- Digitization of books for their research (e.g. books form the collection of Samuel Beckett)
- Digitization of renaissance drama texts
