

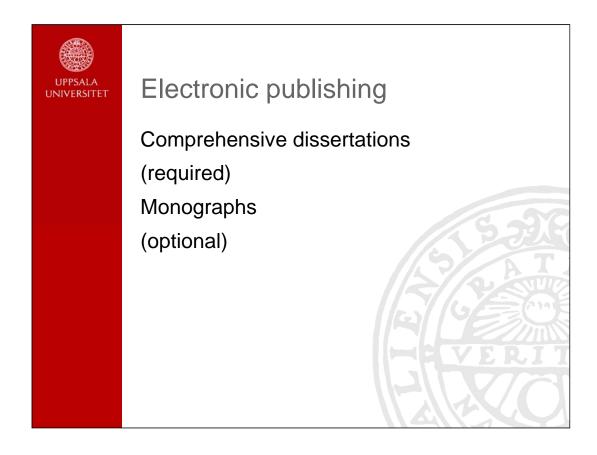

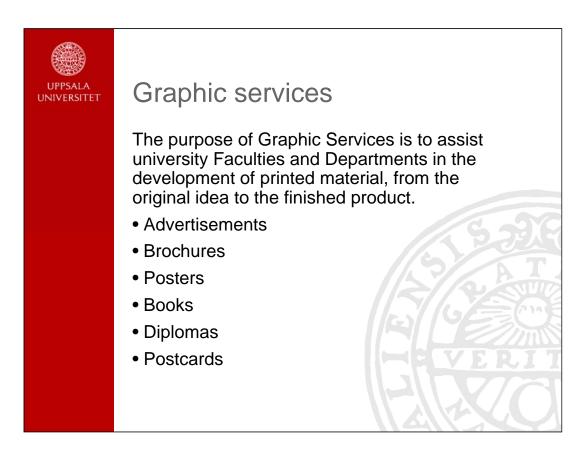
PGS has created templates for Word, Open Office and LaTeX to make it easy for the doctoral students and other authors to write their dissertaitons and books. We also hold courses in how to use the templates where the authors can ask questions about any problems they might have.

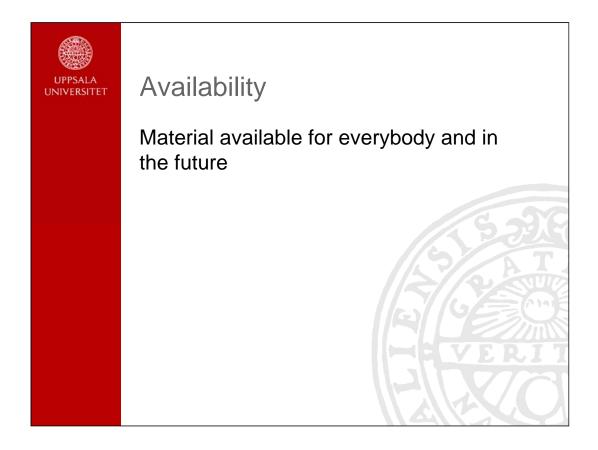
All this makes the printing process as cost efficient as possible.



For the Comprehensive dissertations it is required that the summary is published on the university web. For the monographs it is optional, but the number of electronically published monographs has increased during the last years.



The purpose of Graphic Services is to assist university Faculties and Departments in the development of printed material, from the original idea to the finished product. It is a project that started in january 2006 and will be evaluated this year.



It is important that the material that comes from the university is available for everybody and also in the future.
