# Legal Framework

- **The law on collecting and preserving cultural materials (1433/2007)**
- **Copyright act (404/1961)**

# Purpose

- **A representative and diverse sample of material accessible to the public at different times**
- **Online materials**
  - on servers located in Finland
  - intended to be available to the public in Finland

# The Ways of Collecting Online Materials

- **Annual general web harvest**
- **Theme-based harvests**
  - 6–9 per annum
  - Frequently harvested sites
- **Deposit**
  - Books that have an ISBN number
  - Publications that have an ISSN number
  - Official publications
  - Map publications
  - Internet-only music (recordings, printed music) or music otherwise absent from the National Collection.

# Volume of web harvesting

2010	200 million	25
